Lethbridge professional engineer recipient of top accolade

Edmonton – Professional engineer Mark Bellamy was honoured May 21 with a prestigious national award recognizing his outstanding contributions to both Canadian professional engineering and the Lethbridge community.

Bellamy received the Meritorious Service Award for Community Service at the Engineers Canada Awards Gala in Calgary for his more than 25 years devoted to youth development and the Lethbridge community. The Meritorious Service Award for Community Service recognizes outstanding service and dedication to Canadian society through voluntary participation in community organizations, government sponsored activities, or humanitarian work.

Over his career, Bellamy has volunteered for local APEGA school-outreach programs, served on several community boards, and played a lead role in organizing the annual Lethbridge Regional Science Fair and the 2013 Canada-Wide Science Fair, which brought 480 of Canada's top students and their projects to Lethbridge for a week-long national showcase.
